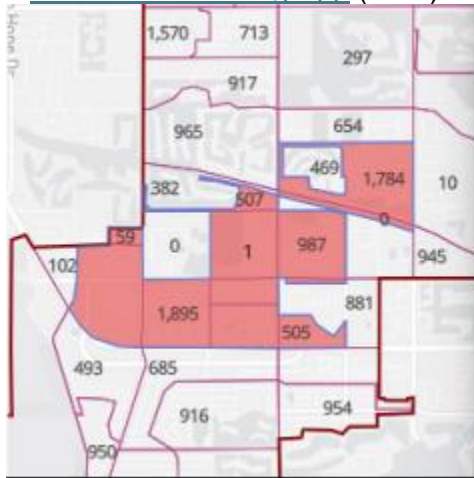
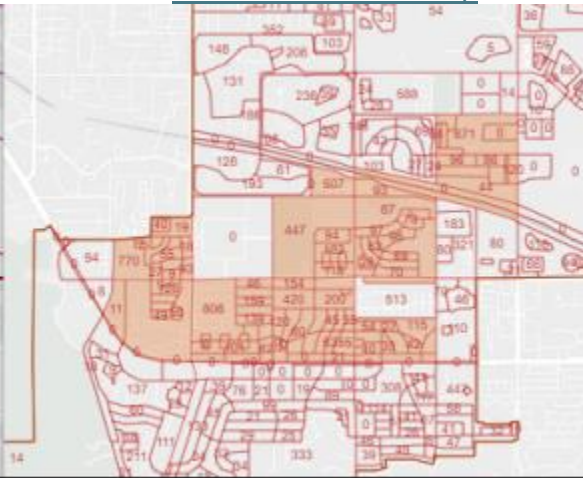


Why does Dave's Redistricting App show different boundaries for District 1 than the actual boundaries?

Those using Dave's Redistricting App (DRA) will notice DRA shows boundaries for District 1 (left image above) that are slightly different than the actual District 1 boundaries (right image above). The affected areas are Portola Country Club and the area north of El Cortez Way/De Anza Way/Ramona Ave. After submission, NDC, the City's demographer, will fine tune those areas to match the image on the right. Do not be concerned that DRA's analysis tools find non-contiguous areas. If you have drawn your map correctly, DRA should show that Portola Country Club is non-contiguous. This will be corrected with NDC's fine tuning.

Why is there a difference? District 1 boundaries shown in DRA (left image above) follow census block geography, which do not precisely match the existing District 1 boundaries. After submission, NDC will fine tune all final maps to match the precise District 1 boundaries.
